1. The qualified resignation of Midshipman Kenneth Leo LEBRUN, Class of 1966, is forwarded and its acceptance is recommended.
2. On the evening of 18 December 1965 Midshipman LEBRUN committed a fraudulent act by marking his roommate present at the 2400 taps accountability inspection when, in fact, the roommate was an unauthorized absentee from the academic limits of the U. S. Naval Academy.
3. Had Midshipman LEBRUN not elected to submit his qualified resignation, a recommendation for his discharge for unsatisfactory conduct would have been forwarded to the Secretary of the Navy. However, the Superintendent considers that the needs of the Naval Academy will be adequately served by the acceptance of Midshipman LEBRUN's qualified resignation.
4. Midshipman LEBRUN was admitted to the U. S. Naval Academy on 27 June 1962 by a Secretary of the Navy appointment (under the provisions of Title 10, Section 5956, U. S. Code). He has elected to fulfill his remaining service obligation by enlistment in the U. S. Naval Reserve.
